Freshers

Funding

If a club or society feels that they are being under funded they may come to me at any time and I will review their finances and determine how much more they need. On a financial note also, for the benefit of treasurers especially, I will strive to change the confusing layout of financial report sheets from the student guidance centre.

PEC

I will fight to lower the yearly fees for the PEC from £237 to the original rates of £100 as well as the single entry fees from £4 back to £2. Additionally they must let in all students at all times not just before 4:30pm if not a member. The public get to use it at anytime if they have a membership, so why shouldn't all fee-paying students? I am going to fight for possible membership to be included in yearly University fees and so technically reducing gym membership to around £20 inclusive.
